So many variations were created! From belgians, to porters, to sours, and everything in between! About 24 beers were judged by club members. Congratulations to the winners:


- 1st Andrew Holman sour lager

Entries can be:

- Dropped off at the Fairgrounds Hoskins Building on <u>Friday, August 4, or</u> <u>Saturday, August 5</u>, from 11 am – 7 pm.
- Dropped off at Arctic Brewing Supply in Anchorage, dates to be announced.
- Mailed in. Mailing entries is highly encouraged.
- Requested for Special Arrangements (not guaranteed) from the Competition Superintendent if unable to bring entries on Entry Day.

The Competition Judging Sessions will be held on Friday August 11, from 6pm <u>- 10 pm and Saturday 12, from 10am -6pm at the Fairgrounds</u>. Judges and *"TAPS Certified" Stewards, especially those with experience, are needed. Please consider supporting this event and helping out; contact the Competition Superintendent. Camping will be available at the grounds.*
