Membership – by the numbers

When the calendar year ends in December, the Great Northern Brewer's Club membership year still has nine months until each annual membership expires, all on the last day of September. Three months into our current year, the Club has received payments for 63 annual memberships. A year ago, the comparable figure was 73 annual memberships. Two years ago, that number was 54.

In September 2023, the end of the last membership year, the club had 90 annual memberships. In September 2022 and September 2021, those numbers were 76 and 81, respectively.

Do those numbers suggest a trend? That is unclear. However, if you have not renewed your membership, you can contribute to a positive trend by renewing your membership.

In early January I will send reminder emails to those who have not renewed their membership. I will also be removing former members from the club's email list.
