This year, we're focusing on the Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP) style guidelines, in preparation for hopefully having an opportunity to take the BJCP exam this winter. September's meeting will be an introduction to the guidelines with opportunities to taste examples of different styles of beer. October will be all about recognizing different flavors and ingredients in beer, possibly with a specific focus on spiced beers, given that we'll be in peak pumpkin spice season.

This year, we'll also be debuting beer tasting sheets at our meetings. The sheets will be like a smaller version of competition scoresheets, where tasters will be able to note the aroma, appearance, flavor, and mouthfeel of the beer and compare them with the BJCP guidelines for the relevant category, if they wish. This will be a areat way for those hoping to take the exam to get practice evaluating beer, and for brewers to get useful feedback.

It's not fall yet, so in the meantime, enjoy the rest of the summer and attend the club's Summer BBQ, starting at 6:00 pm on August 20, at Jeff Loughrey's house, 7051 Lake O the Hills Cir.

We are rapidly approaching the 2024 Alaska State Fair Craft Beverages Competition. Please continue to prepare your favorite entries and consider venturing into new entry areas to expand your beverage making skills.

Fair entries accepted this year in person at Arctic Brewing Supply, 8401 Sandlewood Place, Anchorage, Wednesday July 31, 2024 10am- 5pm; the Palmer Alaska State Fair Grounds, Hoskins Building, Friday, August 2; and Saturday, August 3, 2024 from 11am - 7pm. As always, you can mail your entries if necessary, through approved methods FEDEX or UPS. This must be received before the close of business, August 1, 2024.

Please reserve time to join in the Judging Festivities, which will be, Friday, August 9, 2024 6- 10pm and Saturday, August 10, 2024 10am – 6pm. Also this year, the Fair has granted permission to dry/ self-contained camping for the weekend until Sunday, August 11, 2024 11am, RSVP- ASAP. Fair Admission Tickets will be offered for your time and expertise. We also are planning a spread of food and goodies for your enjoyment during the judging process. We hope that you will join us.

As you probably noticed, we changed the some of the Classes this year. As changes happen and popularity of different beverages ebb and flow, we adjust the Classes for the changes. We are excited this year to continue our relationship with the Great Northern Brewer's Club and look forward to partnering with their expertise and support.

Please remember, that we are required by the Alaska State Fair's Liquor License to have Alcohol Server Training Certified (TAPS/TIPS) Stewards, your support and participation is greatly appreciated. Changes in Club Membership Dues

Eleven years ago, in 2013, the price of an annual membership in the Great Northern Brewers Club increased from \$25 to \$30. That price couldn't last forever.

For the October 2024 - September 2025 membership year, the price has increased. The new price of a membership for two, including a spouse/partner in the same household, is now \$50.



The cost of an annual membership for one remains \$30. Previously, the spouse/partner was included in annual membership at no additional charge. Our hope is that annual members with spouses/partners will renew at the \$50 rate.

Why raise the membership fee? After a decline in membership dues income during Covid, the club has been running an annual deficit since 2022. With the current number of memberships, the \$30 price for one or two members does not balance the budget. The club needs to increase income from dues.

Why add a fee for a spouse/partner in the same household? For alcohol liability insurance purposes, two on a membership costs twice as much as one on a membership. The annual price of our insurance policy is based on the number of members on July 1st.

This year, on July 1st, 59 of 88 annual memberships had a spouse or partner listed in the membership records. Fourteen of 25 lifetime memberships had an associated spouse or partner. For insurance purposes, the club has 186 members. With each member one can associate a cost of insurance before taking into consideration a share of any other club expenses--room rentals and special events including the Industry Meeting with Alaska Craft Beer and Barley Wine Festival.

The Board hopes that annual members with spouses/partners will renew at the \$50 rate.

Club membership is still a great deal! Meetings are opportunity to chat with other brewers about your experiences and plans and find answers to your questions. Brews and snacks are usually plentiful, presentations are interesting and informative, and the parties and events are always fun. The discounts from our sponsors are an exceptional benefit. The newsletter keeps you up to date on events and news and doesn't overwhelm your inbox. Membership is required at several exclusive functions including the Industry reception for the Alaska Craft Brew and Barleywine Festival.

Thank you for your continued membership and activity in the Great Northern Brewers Club.

P.S. The dues page on the club website has not yet been updated to include the new dues structure. The updated site will be announced as soon as ready for business.

This year's event will include many Divisions and Classes to enter. There are also Divisions for Non- Alcoholic Beverages and Label Competition. Professionals are also encouraged to enter in a designated Sub-Category.

Entries can be:

- Dropped off at the Fairgrounds Hoskins Building on <u>Friday, August 2, or</u> <u>Saturday, August 3</u>, from 11 am – 7 pm.
- Dropped off at Arctic Brewing Supply in Anchorage, dates to be announced.
- Mailed in. Mailing entries is highly encouraged.
- Requested for Special Arrangements (not guaranteed) from the Competition Superintendent if unable to bring entries on Entry Day.

The Beer Competition Judging Sessions will be held on Friday August 9, from <u>6pm - 10 pm at the Fairgrounds</u>. Judges and "TAPS Certified" Stewards, especially those with experience, are needed. The owner of McCarthy Lodge, Neil Darish, has extended a special invitation to GNBC members for this adventure.

Accommodations: Ma Johnson's Hotel - 50% OFF from Friday, Aug. 30 through Monday, Sept. 2. Hotel bookings will be by phone, or e-mail: 907-202-6717, Neil.Darish@McCarthyLodge.com rather than through the website so Neil can provide the discount.

Here are additional notes from Neil about the hotel rates:

We can override the 2-night minimum for club members that only can do 1 night.

First Night = \$165 for 1 or 2 people sharing a room, no taxes, includes breakfast.

Two Nights = \$329 for 1 or 2 people sharing a room, no taxes, includes breakfast.

For Club members who can be there Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights: third night for just \$90 per room (includes breakfast at the Salmon & Bear Restaurant across the street).
