Help Bring the BJCP Exam to Alaska

Dear Fellow Beer Connoisseurs,

This winter, during beer week (January 19th-26th, 2025), GNBC is hoping to offer the BJCP testing exam. For those unfamiliar with the BJCP, it's an esteemed program designed to educate and certify beer judges, ensuring a high standard of evaluation and feedback in beer competitions worldwide. Whether you're a seasoned homebrewer, or simply a passionate beer aficionado, BJCP certification has something for you. However, in order to provide this exam, I need your help.

How You Can Get Involved

To make our BJCP exam a resounding success, we are reaching out to our vibrant community. Here's how you can contribute:

- Existing Judges: We need two nationally ranked or higher judges to serve as proctors for this exam. If anyone is willing to serve as Exam Administrator with lots of support from me, that would eliminate the need to apply for a waiver.
- 2. **Aspiring Judges:** Let me know you are interested. We need a minimum of six participants and are capped at 12. You must complete the BJCP entrance examination to take the exam, so start studying now!
- 3. **Helpful volunteers:** On the day of the examination, we will need volunteers to help administer the exam.

Membership News – September 2024

Now is the time to renew your membership in the Great Northern Brewers Club. September 30th is the end of the current membership year. For annual members, after September 30th, your 2023-2024 membership card will no longer be valid at GNBC events or at the vendors who offer discounts to GNBC members. For payments made in early September, I should be able to bring membership cards to the club meeting on Tuesday, September 17^t.

For the 2024-2025 membership year, a single annual membership costs \$30. **The price is \$50 for a couple: two related adults (i.e., spouses or partners) residing in the same household.** Unrelated adults must each pay for their own membership in the club. A GNBC membership card is required for entry to or participation in some events, so be sure to specify both names when applying for couple membership.

For many individuals, a convenient way to pay is to use the form on the club website at https://greatnorthernbrewers.org/membership/ Although PayPal is the payment processor, a PayPal account is not required to make a payment using this online tool. Only a credit card is required.


